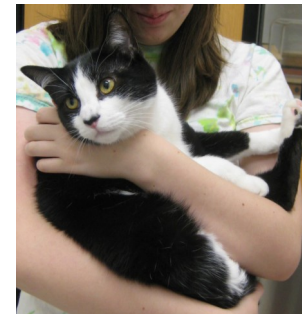
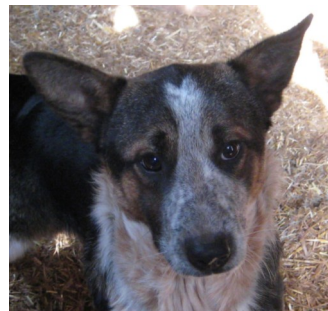

Whether it's our volunteers who come to the very early morning spay/neuter transports or those who help distribute or collect pet food, we owe our sincere thanks to those who support us in so many ways. We rely greatly on the foster families who so generously provide the care - and many times the necessary food and supplies - it takes to keep our foster pets happy and healthy. We are also amazed at the number of wonderful families that reach out to adopt our animals – they (the cats and dogs) are very lucky indeed and certainly, nothing would happen if we didn't have folks like yourselves come forward to help them in this way.

We're also so very appreciative that there are those who share their financial resources with us that make it possible to reach out to the community. All sorts of donors have presented us with gifts both large and small that will continue to fulfill our mission. Another benefit to the community is that we work with several local animal rescue organizations, as well as the Culpeper Animal Shelter to make sure people have reasonable options for their animals.

In late 2010, we added two new programs to our structure, which are to provide discount rabies vaccine vouchers to area residents as well as a disaster preparedness program. In the fall, a workshop was featured and a committee has been formed to begin working with the County and County Animal Shelter, in reviewing our area's contingency plans.

As always, the COMMUNITY SPAY/NEUTER program remains the #1 priority of our organization and is the program that receives the most use from the members of our community. Along with all of the residents who routinely book their surgeries through our organization, we also strive to offer financial assistance to those who need it most. As part of that effort, we've partnered with Saint Seton's Orphaned Animals of Stafford who have been instrumental in providing financial aid to over 100 cats in Culpeper County last year. The Trap-Neuter-Return program continues to flourish and residents are very happy with the results. We have found that these types of assistance toward the spay and neuter initiative, go a long way and is truly the backbone of progress.

This year, we hope to expand our services in all areas and provide the most efficient, long-lasting opportunities to save lives for our local cats and dogs. Thank you for being a part of our accomplishments and successes!
